7/28/2025 FOR FLOOD INSURANCE CLAIMS ASKING FOR RECEIPTS BY AUGUST 15H SO WE CAN ACCOUNT FOR ALL LOSSES.

ANYTIME WASTE BACKED INTO THE CORRAL/FENCE DUMPSTERS ON FOREST LAKE. THEY REPAIRED BUT SAID IT IS DIFFICULT TO GET 2 DUMPSTERS IN CORRAL. THERE ARE NO BOLLARDS (YELLOW POSTS) TO STOP THEM. CARS CLOSE BY MAKE IF DIFFICULT TO GET DUMPSTERS EMPTIED. THEY WILL NO LONGER BE RESPONSIBLE FOR FIXING THE FENCE SHOUD THIS HAPPEN AGAIN. WE TRIED USING ONE 8-YARD DUMPSTERS GETTING PICKED UP 3 DAYS A WEEK INSTEAD OF TWO 6 YARD DUMPSTER PICKED UP 2 DAYS A WEEK AT THE SAME PRICE. WE ARE IN THE PROCESS OF ANYTIME WASTE RETURNING OUR TWO 6-YARD DUMPSTERS DUE TO THE 8-YARD IS MUCH TALLER AND HARD TO LIFT THE TOPS OF LIDS. WE HAD COMPLAINTS FROM RESIDENTS.

AQUATIC CONTROL HAS RECENTLY TREATED LAKES FOR TE FILM. IT GETS TRICKY FOR THEM WITH THE HEAT. THEY WILLL TRY A DIFFERENT COMBINATION IN ABUT 10 DAYS. ALL THEIR PRODUCTS ARE APPROVED BY THE EPA.
