News from Chris Rich:

Greetings! We are well into summer hand I hope everyone is enjoying it as much as I am. After a few major hurdles, our pool is open and being enjoyed (see below!). It has some major refurb planned for the fall which will drastically change its appearance. Although some of our residents are already "certified" we are also working to increase that number in order to allow them to be pool monitors and increase pool occupant capacity from the Health Department's mandated 5 count.



The Marina did not require dredging this year, which was a major windfall for the Harbor and helped with other much needed expenditures.

The required surveys for our Hardy Board siding implementation will be out in the next week or two. We are continuing with quotes and funding initiatives.

We also have some movement on our erosion / wall issue. We are currently reviewing a proposal, from an outside concern, that embraces both, as well as funding. We will discuss that in the community meetings as things develop.

Treasurer's Report from Dave Butke: The Harbor expenses are on budget thru May, but major budgeted items for painting, roads, and roof repairs are expected to take place during the summer season. Our current cash position is \$ 290,000. We will be prepaying our landscaping services for remainder of year to take advantage of sales tax savings of \$1,800.

NEW SECURITY MEASURES from Tommy Cooper: Have you submitted your request for the new car sticker? We've delivered over 100 decals to date and are well on our way to being complete by the July 15 deadline for residents to display the decal on the back glass of any vehicle being parked in the common elements of The Harbor (any parking space other than in your garage). That's also the date we will install the new signs in our common element areas (pool, lake areas, marina, and entry points) stating "PARKING WITH HARBOR AT HARRODS CREEK PERMIT ONLY—VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED".

If you have applied your sticker, thank you! If you haven't, the process of registering your vehicle(s) is quick and simple. Contact Tommy Cooper or Mulloy Properties with a copy of the current registration for each car you have. We will promptly return the attractive decal to you and even put it on your back glass for you if you wish. With the sticker, parking in the common elements of our property will never be challenged. Without it, you run the risk of being asked to prove you are a valid resident of The Harbor or in some cases, especially if you're not with the car, having your vehicle towed.

As stated in previous communication, this is being implemented as part of our increased security measures at The Harbor at Harrods Creek and will be monitored by our Neighborhood Watch Program and others.
